12	On April 21, 2009 at around 4:30 AM, a speeding vehicle crashed through a Police check-post on one of the roads in Mumbai, killed 9 people including 4 Police officers, and injured 1 person. According to the prosecution, one Mr. James Bond who, in an inebriated state, was driving a black Aston Martin Vanquish car at a very high speed that caused the accident. A former member of the Rajya Sabha, K.D. Divan and a Public Prosecutor, J.M. Sinha had been caught in a sting operation conducted by ABP News, when they were trying to convince the chief witness A.B. Mahajan to withdraw his statement in the case. A Series of Videotapes were aired showing collusion between the two while they were attempting to tutor the testimony. Taking suo motu cognizance, the Bombay High Court on May 3, 2012 instituted a contempt proceeding against the lawyers and in exercise of powers under Article 215 of the Constitution of India prohibited them from appearing before the High Court and Subordinate Courts for 6 months.	20	CO4
